~HARMON (26) (Har'mon)

- There is uncertainty as to what is designated by the Hebrew term transliterated Harmon. AS, NW, RS
- And by breaches you will go forth, each one straight ahead, and you will certainly be thrown out to Harmon, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Amos 4:3)
- Some translators giving such widely differing renderings as refuse heap AT and palace KJ. If the reading of the Greek Septuagint, the mountain Ramman, comes closer to the original Hebrew text, then perhaps Harmon refers to the crag of Rimmon.
- Thus they turned and went fleeing to the wilderness to the crag of Rimmon. And they made a gleaning of five thousand men of them on the highways, and they kept following closely after them as far as Gidom and so struck down two thousand more men of them. (Judges 20:45)
- But six hundred men turned and went fleeing to the wilderness to the crag of Rimmon, and they continued to dwell on the crag of Rimmon four months. (Judges 20:47)
