~HARODITE (25) (Ha'rod-ite) [Of, or belonging to, Harod]

- A resident of Harod or a person living near a place called Harod. The term is applied to Shammah and Elika, two of David's mighty men.
- These are the names of the mighty men that belonged to David, Josheb-basshebeth a Tahchemonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over eight hundred slain at one time. (2 Samuel 23:8)
- Shammah the Harodite, Elika the Harodite. (2 Samuel 23:25)
- If Shammah and Shammoth are the same person, then the use of Harorite at;
- Shammoth the Harorite, Helez the Pelonite. (1 Chronicles 11:27)
- Is possibly a scribal error for Harodite, the change perhaps arising from the similarity between the Hebrew letters *r* and *d*.
