(Hash-a-bi'ah) [Yehowah Has Accounted, or Considered]

- An administrator for all the work of Yehowah and for the kings service whom David assigned with his brothers over the territory West of the Jordan. He was a Levite, a descendant of Kohath's son Hebron.
- Of the Hebronites, Hashabiah and his brothers, capable men, a thousand seven hundred, were over the administration of Israel in the region of the Jordan to the west for all the work of Yehowah and for the kings service. (1 Chronicles 26:30)
- The sons of Kohath were Amram, Izhar, Hebron and Uzziel, four. (1 Chronicles 23:12)
