(Hash-a-bi'ah) [Yehowah Has Accounted, or Considered]

- A Levite whose descendant resided in Jerusalem after the Babylonian exile.
- And the first inhabitants that were in their possession in their cities were the Israelites, the priests, the Levites and the Nethinim. (1 Chronicles 9:2)
- And in Jerusalem there dwelt some of the sons of Judah and some of the sons of Benjamin and some of the sons of Ephraim and of Manasseh: (1 Chronicles 9:3)
- And of the Levites there were Shemaiah the son of Hasshub the son of Azrikam the son of Hashabiah from the sons of Merari. (1 Chronicles 9:14)
- Now the princes of the people had their dwelling in Jerusalem, but as for the rest of the people, they cast lots to bring in one out of every ten to dwell in Jerusalem the holy city, and the nine other parts in the other cities. (Nehemiah 11:1)
