~HASHABNAH (20)

(Ha-shab'nah) [shortened form of Hashabneiah]

- One of the heads of the people whose descendant, if not he himself, attested by seal the confession contract made during Nehemiah's governorship.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- The heads of the people, Parosh, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani. (Nehemiah 10:14)
- Rehum, Hashabnah, Maaseiah. (Nehemiah 10:25)
