~HASHABNEIAH 2 (28)

(Hash-ab-nei'ah) [possibly, Yah Has Accounted, or Considered Me]

- One of eight Levites who called upon the sons of Israel to bless Yehowah and his glorious name and then reviewed God's dealings with Israel before the attestation by seal to the confession contract made during Nehemiah's governorship.
- And the Levites Jeshua and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah and Pethahiah went on to say; Rise, bless Yehowah your God from time indefinite to time indefinite. And let them bless your glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise. (Nehemiah 9:5)
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Perhaps, as suggested by the reading in the Syriac Peshitta, he is identical with one of the Levites named Hashabiah, such as the one mentioned at;
- And Hashabiah and with him Jeshaiah from the sons of Merari, his brothers, and their sons, twenty. (Ezra 8:19)
- Mica, Rehob, Hashabiah. (Nehemiah 10:11)
