## ~HASHMONAH (29) (Hash-mo'nah)

- An Israelite camping site, apparently between Mithkah and Moseroth.
- Later they pulled away from Mithkah and went camping in Hashmonah. (Numbers 33:29)
- Next they pulled away from Hashmonah and went camping in Moseroth. (Numbers 33:30)
- Its exact location is uncertain. Hashmonah has been linked with the Wadi Hashim near the suggested location of Kadesh-barnea, and according to another view, it may be the same as Azmon.
- And your boundary must change direction from the south of the ascent of Akrabbim and cross over to Zin, and its termination must prove to be on the south of Kadesh-barnea, and it must go out to Hazar-addar and pass over to Azmon. (Numbers 34:4)
- And the boundary must change direction at Azmon to the torrent valley of Egypt, and its termination must prove to be at the Sea. (Numbers 34:5)
