

~HASTENING (30)

[English, speeding up, stepping up, hurrying, quickening, rushing]

- The congregator describes the wicked as those who are **hastening** to shed blood.
- For their feet are those that run to sheer badness, and they keep **hastening** to shed blood. (**Proverbs 1:16**)
- He that is **hastening** with his feet is sinning.
- Also, that the soul should be without knowledge is not good, and he that is **hastening** with his feet is sinning. (**Proverbs 19:2**)
- He that is **hastening** to gain riches will not remain innocent.
- A man of faithful acts will get many blessings, but he that is **hastening** to gain riches will not remain innocent. (**Proverbs 28:20**)
- Paul was **hastening** to get to Jerusalem for the festival of Pentecost.
- For Paul had decided to sail past Ephesus, in order, that he might not spend any time in the district of Asia, for he was **hastening** to get to Jerusalem on the day of the festival of Pentecost if he possibly could. (**Acts of Apostles 20:16**)
