~HAZER-HATTICON (32) (Ha'zer-hat'ti-con)

- A site mentioned in Ezekiel's vision as on the boundary of Israel and toward the boundary of Hauran.
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; This is the territory that you will assign to yourselves for inheritance as the land for the twelve tribes of Israel, with two pieces of field to Joseph. (Ezekiel 47:13)
- Hamath, Berothah, Sibraim, which is between the boundary of Damascus and the boundary of Hamath, Hazer-hatticon, which is toward the boundary of Hauran. (Ezekiel 47:16)
- A site by this name is unknown, some consider it a scribal error for Hazar-enon.

- And the boundary from the sea must prove to be Hazar-enon, the boundary of Damascus and north and northward, and the boundary of Hamath. This is the northern side. (Ezekiel 47:17)
