~HAZOR 5 (38) (Ha'zor) [Courtyard, Settlement]

- A region in the Arabian Desert east of the Jordan mentioned in the prophecy of Jeremiah as being due for despoiling by King Nebuchadrezzar or Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon.
- For Kedar and the kingdoms of Hazor, which Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon struck down, this is what Yehowah has said; Rise up, go up to Kedar, O men, and despoil the sons of the East. (Jeremiah 49:28)
- Their own tents and their own flocks will be taken, their tent cloths and all their articles. And their own camels will be carried off from them. And they will certainly cry out to them, Fright is all around! (Jeremiah 49:29)
- Flee, take flight far away, go down deep in order to dwell, O inhabitants of Hazor, is the utterance of Yehowah. For Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon has formulated a counsel even against you and has thought out against you a thought. (Jeremiah 49:30)
- Rise up, O men, go up against the nation that is at ease, dwelling in security! Is the utterance of Yehowah. No doors and no bar does it have. Solitary they reside. (Jeremiah 49:31)
- And their camels must become a plunder, and the multitude of their livestock a spoil. And I will scatter them to every wind, those who have their hair clipped at the temples, and from all regions near it I shall bring in their disaster, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 49:32)
- And Hazor must become the lair of jackals, a desolate waste to time indefinite. No man will dwell there, and in her no son of mankind will reside as an alien. (Jeremiah 49:33)
