~HEALTHFUL (82)

[English, healthy, good for your health, good for you, beneficial, wholesome, nourishing; Opposite of, unhealthy]

- Elisha made the water **healthful** by throwing salt into it, for it was causing miscarriages.
- Then he went on out to the source of the water and threw salt in it and said; This is what Yehowah has said; I do make this water healthful. No more will death or any causing of miscarriages result from it. (2 Kings 2:21)
- That is why the wicked make sacrificial smoke to the means by which they wickedly rule over the righteous ones, for by this dragnet they have a good healthful life, and fare well, though at the expense of others.
- That is why he offers sacrifice to his dragnet and makes sacrificial smoke to his fishing net, for by them his portion is well oiled, and his food is healthful. (Habakkuk 1:16)
- The Law is also for men who lie with males, kidnappers, liars and false swearers. It is against all of these ones, and also against whatever thing, is against the healthful teaching.
- Fornicators, men who lie with males, kidnappers, liars, false swearers, and whatever other thing is in opposition to the healthful teaching (1 Timothy 1:10)
- Paul then warns Timothy to watch out for those who teach other doctrine, and do not assent to keeping this pattern of healthful words, that come from Jesus Christ, and the teaching that accords with godly devotion.
- If any man teaches other doctrine and does not assent to healthful words, those of our Lord Jesus Christ, nor to the teaching that accords with godly devotion. (1 Timothy 6:3)
- Paul now encourages Timothy, to keep holding tightly the pattern of healthful words, that Paul previously told him, doing so with faith and love for Jesus Christ.

- Keep holding the pattern of healthful words that you heard from me with the faith and love that are in connection with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 1:13)
- Paul now warns, that there will be a period of time, when they will not put up with the healthful teachings, which Timothy has been taught by Paul and others. Then, men will search out teachers for themselves, that will tell them only what they want to hear, so as to have their own ears tickled.
- For there will be a period of time when they will not put up with the healthful teaching, but, in accord with their own desires, they will accumulate teachers for themselves to have their ears tickled. (2 Timothy 4:3)
- The overseer must hold firmly to the faithful word of truth, the Bible, in his art of teaching. Thus he will be able to exhort by means of healthful teachings, contained therein, and to reprove those, who choose to contradict.
- Holding firmly to the faithful word as respects his art of teaching, that he may be able both to exhort by the teaching that is healthful and to reprove those who contradict. (Titus 1:9)
- Paul now encourages Titus to take a different course, for he should keep on speaking things, that are spiritually healthful, and which build up Christian men and women in their faith.
- You, however, keep on speaking what things are fitting for healthful teaching. (Titus 2:1)
