~**HEARERS** (34)

[English, One who, perceives sound, has the sense of hearing, understands, opens oneself to counsel]

- The Israelites profaned Yehowah for morsels of bread yet they turned around justice preferring to believe lies rather than the truth. His people therefore became lovers or willing hearers of the lie.
- And will you profane me toward my people for the handfuls of barley and for the morsels of bread, in order to put to death the souls that ought not to die and in order to preserve alive the souls that ought not to live by your lie to my people, the hearers of a lie? (Ezekiel 13:19)
- Paul explains that the hearers of the Law gain no righteousness before God, but the doers of the Law will be declared righteous.
- For the hearers of Law are not the ones righteous before God, but the doers of Law will be declared righteous. (Romans 2:13)
- However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (James 1:22)
- Christians should speak for the upbuilding of others so as to impart what is favorable to the hearers.
- Let a rotten saying not proceed out of your mouth, but whatever saying is good for building up as the need may be, that it may impart what is favorable to the hearers. (Ephesians 4:29)
