~HELBON (18) (Hel'bon)

- A place noted for its fine wine, which was highly valued by the city of Tyre.
- Damascus was your merchant in the abundance of your works, because of the abundance of all your valuable things, with the wine of Helbon and the wool of reddish gray. (Ezekiel 27:18)
- Helbon is generally identified with the modern village of Halbun, about 20 kilometers (12 miles) North-Northwest of Damascus. The village lies in a narrow valley with terraced vineyards located far up the mountain slopes. In ancient times, not only Tyre but also Assyria, Babylonia, and Persia obtained the wine of Helbon.
