## ~HELEK (34)

(He'lek) (He'lek-ites) [a shortened form of Hilkiah, meaning My Portion or Share Is Yehowah]

- The second-listed son of Gilead, and great-grandson of Manasseh. He founded the family of the Helekites that was numbered in the census at the end of the Israelites wilderness trek and that received an inheritance in Manasseh's territory.
- And Moses and Eleazar the priest proceeded to speak with them in the desert plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho, saying; (Numbers 26:3)
- Take the sum of them from the age of twenty years and upward, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. Now the sons of Israel who went out of the land of Egypt were. (Numbers 26:4)
- The sons of Manasseh were. Of Machir the family of the Machirites. And Machir became father to Gilead. Of Gilead the family of the Gileadites. (Numbers 26:29)
- These were the sons of Gilead. Of Iezer the family of the Iezerites, of Helek the family of the Helekites. (Numbers 26:30)
- And there came to be a lot for the sons of Manasseh who were left over according to their families, for the sons of Abi-ezer and the sons of Helek and the sons of Asriel and the sons of Shechem and the sons of Hepher and the sons of Shemida. These were the sons of Manasseh the son of Joseph, the males according to their families. (Joshua 17:2)
