(He'lon) [from a root meaning vital energy]

- **A man of the tribe of Zebulun whose son Eliab was the chieftain of his tribe during Israel's trek through the wilderness.**
- **And some men should be with you, one man to a tribe, each is a head to the house of his fathers. (Numbers 1:4)**
- **Of Zebulun, Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 1:9)**
- **These are the ones called of the assembly, the chieftains of the tribes of their fathers. They are the heads of the thousands of Israel. (Numbers 1:16)**
- **And the tribe of Zebulun, and the chieftain for the sons of Zebulun is Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 2:7)**
- **On the third day there was the chieftain for the sons of Zebulun, Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 7:24)**
- **And over the army of the tribe of the sons of Zebulun there was Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 10:16)**
