(He'lon) [from a root meaning vital energy]

- A man of the tribe of Zebulun whose son Eliab was the chieftain of his tribe during Israel's trek through the wilderness.
- And some men should be with you, one man to a tribe, each is a head to the house of his fathers. (Numbers 1:4)
- Of Zebulun, Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 1:9)
- These are the ones called of the assembly, the chieftains of the tribes of their fathers. They are the heads of the thousands of Israel. (Numbers 1:16)
- And the tribe of Zebulun, and the chieftain for the sons of Zebulun is Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 2:7)
- On the third day there was the chieftain for the sons of Zebulun, Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 7:24)
- And over the army of the tribe of the sons of Zebulun there was Eliab the son of Helon. (Numbers 10:16)
