- The Bible comments that no hands turned helpfully to Sodom at her destruction.
- The punishment for the error of the daughter of my people also becomes greater than the punishment for the sin of Sodom; Which was overthrown as in a moment, and to which no hands turned helpfully. (Lamentations 4:6)
- When Paul and his companions were shipwrecked the people of the island received them helpfully because of the rain and the cold weather.
- And the foreign-speaking people showed us extraordinary human kindness, for they kindled a fire and received all of us helpfully because of the rain that was falling and because of the cold. (Acts of Apostles 28:2)
