## ~HELPLESS (42)

[English, powerless, unable to help, weak, feeble, dependent, vulnerable, unaided, Opposite of, self-reliant]

- Yehowah promised to feel regret over his people after bringing destruction upon them for their sins, because only a helpless and worthless one was left.
- For Yehowah will judge his people and he will feel regret over his servants, because he will see that support has disappeared and there is only a helpless and worthless one. (Deuteronomy 32:36)
- Yehowah promised to bring an end to Jeroboam's offspring until not even a helpless and worthless one was left over, because of Jereboam's leading Israel to sin. Later he did the same to the house of Ahab.
- For that reason here I am bringing calamity upon the house of Jeroboam, and I shall certainly cut off from Jeroboam anyone urinating against a wall, a helpless and worthless one in Israel, and I shall indeed make a clean sweep behind the house of Jeroboam, just as one clears away the dung until it is disposed of. (1 Kings 14:10)
- Here I am bringing calamity upon you, and I shall certainly make a clean sweep after you and cut off from Ahab anyone urinating against a wall and the helpless and worthless one in Israel. (1 Kings 21:21)
- And the whole house of Ahab must perish, and I must cut off from Ahab anyone urinating against a wall and any helpless and worthless one in Israel. (2 Kings 9:8)
- Yehowah saw the bitter affliction of his people for they were helpless having no helper.
- For Yehowah had seen the very bitter affliction of Israel. There was neither any helpless one nor any worthless one, nor was there a helper for Israel. (2 Kings 14:26)
