~HENADAD (49) (Hen'a-dad)

- A Levite whose descendants apparently served as supervisors in connection with the rebuilding of the temple by Zerubbabel.
- And in the second year of their coming to the house of the true God at Jerusalem, in the second month, Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and Jeshua the son of Jehozadak and the rest of their brothers, the priests and the Levites, and all those who had come out of the captivity to Jerusalem started, and they now put in positions the Levites from twenty years of age upward to act as supervisors over the work of the house of Yehowah. (Ezra 3:8)
- Accordingly Jeshua, his sons and his brothers, and Kadmiel and his sons, the sons of Judah, stood up as one group to act as supervisors over the doers of the work in the house of the true God, also the sons of Henadad, their sons and their brothers, the Levites. (Ezra 3:9)
- Two of Henadad's descendants are specifically referred to as sharing in the repair of Jerusalem's wall, and one of his descendants attested by seal the confession contract made during Nehemiah's governorship.
- After him the Levites did repair work, Rehum the son of Bani, at his side Hashabiah, a prince of half the district of Keilah, did repair work for his district. (Nehemiah 3:17)
- After him their brothers did repair work, Bavvai the son of Henadad, a prince of half the district of Keilah. (Nehemiah 3:18)
- After him Binnui the son of Henadad repaired another measured section, from the house of Azariah as far as the Buttress and as far as the corner. (Nehemiah 3:24)
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)

Also the Levites, Jeshua the son of Azaniah, Binnui of the sons of Henadad, Kadmiel (Nehemiah 10:9)
