## ~HERDER (70)

[English, One Who, groups, gathers a flock, gathers a drove, gathers a pack]

- Abel came to be a herder of the flocks by profession.
- Later she again gave birth, to his brother Abel. And Abel came to be a herder of sheep, but Cain became a cultivator of the ground. (Genesis 4:2)
- Joseph told his brothers to tell Pharaoh that they were herders of flocks by profession.
- You must say; Your servants have continued to be stock raisers from our youth until now, both we and our forefathers, in order, that you may dwell in the land of Goshen, because every herder of sheep is a detestable thing to Egypt. (Genesis 46:34)
- A quarrel arose between the herders of Lot and Abraham because of their large numbers and close proximity.
- And a quarrel arose between the herders of Abram's livestock and the herders of Lot's livestock, and at that time the Canaanite and the Perizzite were dwelling in the land. (Genesis 13:7)
- Pharaoh asked Joseph's brothers what their occupation was and they told him that they were herders of sheep.
- Then Pharaoh said to his brothers; What is your occupation? So they said to Pharaoh; Your servants are herders of sheep, both we and our forefathers. (Genesis 47:3)
- When these things happened the men who were herding the two thousand swine went into the city nearby, and they reported there everything they had seen, including the affair of the demon-possessed men.
- But the herders fled and, going into the city, they reported everything, including the affair of the demon-possessed men. (Matthew 8:33)

- However the men who were charged with herding the swine fled immediately, and they entered into the city nearby, and also the countryside all around, and told the people there, what things had happened to the swine.
- But the herders of them fled and reported it in the city and in the countryside, and people came to see what it was that had happened. (Mark 5:14)
- Now the men who were herding the swine, upon seeing what had happened, fled immediately, and reported it to those in the city, and to all the countryside round about.
- But when the herders saw what had happened, they fled and reported it to the city and to the countryside. (Luke 8:34)
