~HERESH (19) (He'resh) [Deaf, Keeping Silent]

- A Levite whose name appears in a list of those returning from exile in Babylon.
- As for all Israelites, they were enrolled genealogically, and there they are written in the Book of the Kings of Israel. And Judah itself was taken into exile at Babylon for their unfaithfulness. (1 Chronicles 9:1)
- And of the Levites there were Shemaiah the son of Hasshub the son of Azrikam the son of Hashabiah from the sons of Merari. (1 Chronicles 9:14)
- And Bakbakkar, Heresh and Galal, and Mattaniah the son of Mica the son of Zichri the son of Asaph. (1 Chronicles 9:15)
