~HERES 1 (27) (He'res) [Sun]

- A mountain from the Hebrew *har*, where Amorites kept dwelling despite Israel's conquest of Canaan. It is associated with the territory of the tribe of Dan.
- And the Amorites kept pressing the sons of Dan into the mountainous region, for they did not allow them to come down into the low plain. (Judges 1:34)
- So the Amorites persisted in dwelling in Mount Heres and in Aijalon and Shaalbim. But the hand of the house of Joseph got to be so heavy that they were forced into task work. (Judges 1:35)
- Most scholars consider it the equivalent of Ir-shemesh, which is evidently the same as Beth-shemesh on the boundary of Judah and Dan, mentioned at;
- And the border of their inheritance came to be Zorah and Eshtaol and Ir-shemesh. (Joshua 19:41)
