

~HESITATE (27)

[English, be uncertain, be indecisive, vacillate, delay, waver, falter, pause,]

- Yehowah will repay to his face the one who hates him, he will not **hesitate** to do so.
- But repaying to his face the one who hates him by destroying him. He will not **hesitate** toward the one who hates him. He will repay him to his face. (**Deuteronomy 7:10**)
- The Bible encourages men to pay their vows to God, do not **hesitate** to do so.
- Whenever you vow a vow to God, do not **hesitate** to pay it, for there is no delight in the stupid ones. What you vow, pay. (**Ecclesiastes 5:4**)
- The disciples sent men to Peter to ask him not to **hesitate** to come to them.
- Now as Lydda was near Joppa, when the disciples heard that Peter was in this city they dispatched two men to him to entreat him; Please do not **hesitate** to come on as far as us. (**Acts of Apostles 9:38**)
