[English, be uncertain, be indecisive, vacillate, delay, waver, falter, pause,]

- Yehowah will repay to his face the one who hates him, he will not hesitate to do so.
- But repaying to his face the one who hates him by destroying him. He will not hesitate toward the one who hates him. He will repay him to his face. (Deuteronomy 7:10)
- The Bible encourages men to pay their vows to God, do not hesitate to do so.
- Whenever you vow a vow to God, do not hesitate to pay it, for there is no delight in the stupid ones. What you vow, pay. (Ecclesiastes 5:4)
- The disciples sent men to Peter to ask him not to hesitate to come to them.
- Now as Lydda was near Joppa, when the disciples heard that Peter was in this city they dispatched two men to him to entreat him; Please do not hesitate to come on as far as us. (Acts of Apostles 9:38)
