[English, undecided, resolute, vacillating, sitting on the fence, uncertain, wavering, hesitant, unsure, faltering, Opposite of, **decided]**

- The king of Israel said to his servants, do not you know that Ramoth-gilead belongs to us, and yet you are hesitating to take it back from Syria.
- Then the king of Israel said to his servants; Do you really know that Ramoth-gilead belongs to us? Yet we are **hesitating** to take it out of the hand of the king of Syria. (**1 Kings 22:3**)
- When Yehowah caused Assyrian forces to flee empty handed in the middle of the night, lepers found their camp and knew that if they **hesitated** to take spoil and did not immediately report it that they would be found guilty.
- Finally they began to say the one to the other; It is not right what we are doing. This day is a day of Good News! If we are **hesitating**, and we actually wait until the morning light, guilt must also catch up with us. So now come and let us enter and make report at the king's house. (**2 Kings 7:9**)
