[English, undecided, resolute, vacillating, sitting on the fence, uncertain, wavering, hesitant, unsure, faltering, Opposite of, decided]

- The king of Israel said to his servants, do not you know that Ramoth-gilead belongs to us, and yet you are hesitating to take it back from Syria.
- Then the king of Israel said to his servants; Do you really know that Ramoth-gilead belongs to us? Yet we are hesitating to take it out of the hand of the king of Syria. (1 Kings 22:3)
- When Yehowah caused Assyrian forces to flee empty handed in the middle of the night, lepers found their camp and knew that if they hesitated to take spoil and did not immediately report it that they would be found guilty.
- Finally they began to say the one to the other; It is not right what we are doing. This day is a day of Good News! If we are hesitating, and we actually wait until the morning light, guilt must also catch up with us. So now come and let us enter and make report at the king's house. (2 Kings 7:9)
