~HETHLON (25) (Heth'lon)

- A site, the approach to which lay on the northern border of the land of Israel, as seen in Ezekiel's vision.
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; This is the territory that you will assign to yourselves for inheritance as the land for the twelve tribes of Israel, with two pieces of field to Joseph. (Ezekiel 47:13)
- And this is the boundary of the land to the northern side, from the Great Sea by the way to Hethlon, as one comes to Zedad. (Ezekiel 47:15)
- And these are the names of the tribes. From the northern extremity, on the side by the way of Hethlon to the entering in to Hamath, Hazar-enan, the boundary of Damascus northward, on the side of Hamath, and it must prove to have an eastern border and the western, Dan one portion. (Ezekiel 48:1)
- Some scholars tentatively identify Hethlon with modern-day Haitla, about 35 kilometers (22 miles) Northeast of Tripoli, Lebanon.
