(Hid'dai)

- One of the mighty men in David's army. **Hiddai** was from the torrent valleys of Gaash in the mountainous region of Ephraim.
- These are the names of the mighty men that belonged to David; Josheb-basshebeth a Tahchemonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over eight hundred slain at one time. **(2 Samuel 23:8)**
- Benaiah a Pirathonite, **Hiddai** of the torrent valleys of Gaash. **(2 Samuel 23:30)**
- So they buried him in the territory of his inheritance in Timnath-serah, which is in the mountainous region of Ephraim, north of Mount Gaash. **(Joshua 24:30)**
- His name is given as **Hurai** at;
- **Hurai** from the torrent valleys of Gaash, Abiel the Arbathite. **(1 Chronicles 11:32)**
