~HIDDAI (24) (Hid'dai)

- One of the mighty men in David's army. Hiddai was from the torrent valleys of Gaash in the mountainous region of Ephraim.
- These are the names of the mighty men that belonged to David; Josheb-basshebeth a Tahchemonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over eight hundred slain at one time. (2 Samuel 23:8)
- Benaiah a Pirathonite, Hiddai of the torrent valleys of Gaash. (2 Samuel 23:30)
- So they buried him in the territory of his inheritance in Timnathserah, which is in the mountainous region of Ephraim, north of Mount Gaash. (Joshua 24:30)
- His name is given as Hurai at;
- Hurai from the torrent valleys of Gaash, Abiel the Arbathite. (1 Chronicles 11:32)
