[English, extremely, very, exceedingly, very much, greatly, decidedly, vastly]

- When Yehowah God killed the Egyptian armies at the Red Sea he became highly exalted in the eyes of his people.
- At that time Moses and the sons of Israel proceeded to sing this song to Yehowah and to say the following; Let me sing to Yehowah, for he has become highly exalted the horse and its rider he has pitched into the sea. (Exodus 15:1)
- And Miriam kept responding to the men; Sing to Yehowah, for he has become highly exalted. The horse and its rider he has pitched into the sea. (Exodus 15:21)
- David's kingship became highly exalted in the eyes of all Israel.
- And David came to know that Yehowah had firmly established him as king over Israel, for his kingship was highly exalted on account of his people Israel. (1 Chronicles 14:2)
- Sanballat became highly offended when he heard about the rebuilding of the waterless of Jerusalem.
- Now it came about that, as soon as Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the wall, he became angry and highly offended, and he kept deriding the Jews. (Nehemiah 4:1)
- When Queen Vashti refused to come into the king's presence, he became highly indignant.
- But Queen Vashti kept refusing to come at the kings word that was conveyed by means of the court officials. At this the king grew highly indignant and his very rage flared up within him. (Esther 1:12)
- Yehowah constitutes his Messianic king highly exalted forever.
- For you constitute him highly blessed forever. You make him feel glad with the rejoicing at your face. (Psalms 21:6)

- If men would highly esteem wisdom and knowledge, it would exalt them.
- Highly esteem it, and it will exalt you. It will glorify you because you embrace it. (Proverbs 4:8)
- Their chiefs and highly respected ones and counselors will all be lacking in wisdom and understanding of Yehowah's advancing purposes. Much of what they do to get understanding of Yehowah's purpose, amounts to little more than divination, or a practice of magical arts, for Yehowah has cut them off from his true understanding, because they are working directly against his purposes.
- Chief of fifty and highly respected man and counselor and expert in magical arts, and the skilled charmer. (Isaiah 3:3)
- Yehowah here likens the nation to an animal, whose parts work just the opposite to how they should. The aged and highly respected men who direct the nation, should themselves be listening to God's true prophets. Instead they are like the head, which wags the tail. They only listen to false prophets, who tell them exactly what they want to hear.
- The aged and highly respected one is the head, and the prophet giving false instruction is the tail. (Isaiah 9:15)
- The joyful harvest festivals with their boisterous music of tambourine, harp and dancing have ceased. The joy of the highly elated ones has discontinued.
- The exultation of the tambourines has ceased, the noise of the highly elated ones has discontinued, the exultation of the harp has ceased. (Isaiah 24:8)
- Surely the wall of obstruction, that they have raised up to doing God's will, must fall. It is like a protruding swelling out on a highly raised wall, there is no support beneath it, so to lean on this wall would cause its collapse. Likewise, anyone who leans on the understanding of these men, The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses, will be subject to sudden breakdown and collapse.
- Therefore for you this error will become like a broken section about to fall down, a swelling out in a highly raised wall, the breakdown of which may come suddenly, in an instant. (Isaiah

30:13)

- Among all the sects of Judaism and Christendom only thorns and spiny bushes grow, they have no good fruitage. This lack of good spiritual fruitage lays in men who exult in their own spiritual badness, and who occupy the highest spiritual positions in the nation, the highly elated town.
- Upon the ground of my people merely thorns, spiny bushes come up, for they are upon all the houses of exultation, yes, the highly elated town. (Isaiah 32:13)
- Yet to Jonah, this turn of events was highly displeasing, and thus he became hot with anger. His mindset was that his words had not yet come true, while Yehowah God's mindset was that his work was highly successful, for he had turned the people back from their wicked course, and brought salvation to many, this being Yehowah God's purpose in the first place.
- To Jonah, though, it was highly displeasing, and he got to be hot with anger. (Jonah 4:1)
- Now as Gabriel appeared to Mary he greeted her with the words; Good day, highly favored one, Yehowah is with you.
- And when he went in before her he said, Good day, highly favored one, Yehowah is with you. (Luke 1:28)
