[English, caught up delayed, slowed down, stalled, held up, over involved, mired, stuck]

- Jesus criticized the Pharisees and Sadducees who took away the key of knowledge and hindered others from learning God's true ways.
- Woe to you who are versed in the Law, because you took away the key of knowledge; You yourselves did not go in, and those going in you hindered! (Luke 11:52)
- Paul spoke of trying to come to see his Roman brothers, but spoke of being hindered by other things not mentioned in detail.
- But I do not want you to fail to know, brothers, that I many times purposed to come to you, but I have been hindered until now, in order, that I might acquire some fruitage also among you even as among the rest of the nations. (Romans 1:13)
- Therefore also I was many times hindered from getting to you. (Romans 15:22)
- Paul asked the Galatian Christians pointedly, who was hindering them from obeying the Good News of the truth.
- You were running well. Who hindered you from keeping on obeying the truth? (Galatians 5:7)
- Peter showed that a man's prayers could be hindered if he did not deal according to knowledge with his wife and assign her honor.
- You husbands, continue dwelling in like manner with them according to knowledge, assigning them honor as to a weaker vessel, the feminine one, since you are also heirs with them of the undeserved favor of life, in order for your prayers not to be hindered. (1 Peter 3:7)
- Balaam got a reproof when a voiceless beast of burden hindered the prophets mad course of trying to go against God and curse the Israelite nation against God's will.
- But got a reproof for his own violation of what was right. A

voiceless beast of burden, making utterance with the voice of a man, hindered the prophets mad course. (2 Peter 2:16)
