~HIRAM-ABIV (15) (Hi'ram-a'biv) [Hiram His Father]

- A term used in reference to the skilled craftsman sent from Tyre to supervise construction of the furnishings of Solomon's temple. It seems to indicate that Hiram was father, not in a literal sense, but in that he was a master workman.
- And the cans and the shovels and the forks and all their utensils Hiram-abiv made for King Solomon for the house of Yehowah, of polished copper. (2 Chronicles 4:16)
