~HIRAM-ABI (14) (Hi'ram-a'bi) [Hiram My Father]

- An appellation applied to the skillful man whom the king of Tyre sent to make the furnishings of Solomon's temple. It evidently indicated that Hiram was father in the sense of being a master workman.
- And now I do send a skillful man, experienced in understanding, belonging to Hiram-abi. (2 Chronicles 2:13)
