

### ~HORRIBLE (49)

[English, horrifying, awful, terrible, nasty, atrocious, ghastly, hideous, horrific, repulsive, dreadful, upsetting, shocking, staggering, unspeakable, horrendous, appalling, Opposite of, lovely, beautiful]

- Maacah made a **horrible** idol which Asa later cut down.
- As for even Maacah his grandmother, he went on to remove her from being lady, because she had made a **horrible** idol to the sacred pole, after which Asa cut down her horrible idol and burned it at the torrent valley of Kidron. (1 Kings 15:13)
- As for even Maacah his grandmother, Asa the king himself removed her from being lady, because she had made a **horrible** idol for the sacred pole, and then Asa cut down her horrible idol and pulverized it and burned it in the torrent valley of Kidron. (2 Chronicles 15:16)
- Yehowah, through Jeremiah, described the lack of justice and compassion among his people as a **horrible thing**.
- An astonishing situation, even a **horrible thing**, has been brought to be in the land. (Jeremiah 5:30)
- The **horrible** thing that Judah later did was to follow after idols and her own thinking.
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; Ask for yourselves, please, among the nations. Who has heard things like these? There is a **horrible** thing that the virgin of Israel has done to an excess. (Jeremiah 18:13)
- Jerusalem's prophets practiced horrible things including committing adultery, lying, and supporting the evildoers in their works. To Yehowah they were just like Sodom and Gomorrah.
- And in the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen **horrible** things, committing adultery and walking in falsehood, and they have strengthened the hands of evildoers in order, that they should not return, each one from his own badness. To me all of them have become like Sodom, and the inhabitants of her like Gomorrah. (Jeremiah 23:14)

- In the house of Israel I have seen a **horrible** thing. There, there is fornication on the part of Ephraim. Israel has defiled itself. (**Hosea 6:10**)
