

~HOSHEA 1 (23)

(Ho-she'a) [shortened form of Hoshaiiah]

- One of the 12 sent by Moses to spy out the Land of Promise in **1512 B.C.E**, son of Nun of the tribe of Ephraim. Moses, however, preferred to call him Jehoshua, meaning, **Yehowah Is Salvation**.
- Of the tribe of Ephraim, **Hoshea** the son of Nun. (**Numbers 13:8**)
- These are the names of the men whom Moses sent to spy out the land. And Moses continued to call **Hoshea** the son of Nun Jehoshua. (**Numbers 13:16**)
- In **Greek** the **Septuagint** has the name reading *I-e-sous'* or Jesus. As Moses successor he was generally called by the shortened **Hebrew** form *Joshua*.
- And it came about after the death of Moses the servant of Yehowah that Yehowah proceeded to say to **Joshua** the son of Nun, the minister of Moses. (**Joshua 1:1**)
