~HOWLING (148)

[English, cry, crying, lamentation, weeping, dirge, expression of grief]

- Yehowah God found his people in a howling desert and proceeded to encircle and care for them.
- He came to find him in a wilderness land, and in an empty, howling desert. He began to encircle him, to take care of him, to safeguard him as the pupil of his eye. (Deuteronomy 32:10)
- At her fall the **howling** will be a very great outcry, it is one that will be heard from one end of her territory to the other end.
- For the outcry has gone around the territory of Moab. The howling thereof is clear to Eglaim, the howling thereof is clear to Beer-elim. (Isaiah 15:8)
- This non-spiritual land, will become a lonely waterless place, nearly devoid of life, because the vast majority of people during the thousand years, will be spiritual men and women who draw close to Yehowah and his principled spiritual teachings. Then only a very few lonely individuals like howling animals, who refuse to make spiritual progress, will haunt these regions.
- And haunters of waterless regions must meet up with howling animals, and even the goat-shaped demon will call to its companion. Yes, there the nightjar will certainly take its ease and find for itself a resting-place. (Isaiah 34:14)
- Yes, what interest does Yehowah have in Jehovah's Witnesses? His true anointed sons were sold to her for nothing. They became her captives, only because it was part of God's grand purpose, for it to occur this way.
- The ruling ones of Jehovah's Witnesses, who themselves claim to be anointed ones, have howled at them; Preach! Preach! Preach! They do this, so that they can grow their worldwide organization, and gain more money and prominence.
- Yet constantly, all day long, Yehowah's great name, his flawless reputation, is being defamed by a people who take his name, kill through disfellowshipping his anointed sons, reject the Messiah, and

call truth from him apostasy. This harlot has treated Yehowah will disrespect, by practicing loose conduct, playing fast and loose with divine principles.

- And now, what interest do I have here? Is the utterance of Yehowah. For my people were taken for nothing. The very ones ruling over them kept howling, is the utterance of Yehowah, and constantly, all day long, my name was being treated with disrespect. (Isaiah 52:5)
- The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses, her anointed remnant, and all of the other tree-like leaders of Christendom will all howl, when Yehowah's sends the nations against them to despoil them. Their flocks will all scatter, and their very place will cease to exist.
- Listen! The outcry of the shepherds, and the howling of the majestic ones of the flock, for Yehowah is despoiling their pasturage. (Jeremiah 25:36)
- Therefore with her the demons will dwell, the haunters of the waterless regions, where there is no truth. She has chosen a course of following the will of the demons by destroying God's own sons and rejecting truth, and her end will be destruction. Her very way will disappear, and no more will she reside for generation after generation. False religion will be gone from the earth forever.
- Therefore the haunters of waterless regions will dwell with the howling animals, and in her the ostriches must dwell, and she will nevermore be dwelt in, nor will she reside for generation after generation. (Jeremiah 50:39)
- His people, though dedicated to him, have looked elsewhere for support of their ideas and hopes. Despite being in sore straits, howling upon their beds over their miseries, they have still not turned back to him. They have taken his many blessings like an abundance of bread and wine, and have become lazy, turning against, the very one who provides these things to them.
- And they did not call to me for aid with their heart, although they kept howling on their beds. On account of their grain and sweet wine they kept loafing about, they kept turning against me. (Hosea 7:14)

- Then Yehowah God shows, that the songs of the temple that they once sang, will become only a howling over their pain. For many of their carcasses will fall in death, and in every place within their land, people will have to throw them out for burial, and thus the music will be hushed.
- And the songs of the temple will actually be a howling in that day, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. There will be many a carcass. In every place one will certainly throw them out, hush! (Amos 8:3)
- Then in that day, Yehowah God assures his people, that there will occur a sound of outcry at the Fish Gate of Jerusalem, and a howling from the second quarter, and they will hear a great crashing from the hills.
- And there must occur on that day, is the utterance of Yehowah, the sound of an outcry from the Fish Gate, and a howling from the second quarter, and a great crashing from the hills.

 (Zephaniah 1:10)
- Zechariah is now told to listen to the howling of their leaders, their religious shepherds, for their majesty has been despoiled. Listen also to the leaders who are roaring like maned young lions, for their resting place along the proud thickets of the Jordan in the regions of Bashan have been despoiled. There is no place for them any longer.
- Listen! The howling of shepherds, for their majesty has been despoiled. Listen! The roaring of maned young lions, for the proud thickets along the Jordan have been despoiled. (Zechariah 11:3)
- James now addresses the rich men who spend all their days gathering riches, riches which just multiply their miseries. Indeed they should howl over the additional miseries that are coming upon them, because of the course that they are set upon.
- Come, now, you rich men, weep, howling over your miseries that are coming upon you. (James 5:1)
