

## ~HUMBLING (27)

[English, awe-inspiring, awesome, overwhelming]

- When Manasseh found himself in great distress then he went to **humbling** himself before Yehowah and gained forgiveness.
- And as soon as it caused him distress, he softened the face of Yehowah his God and kept **humbling** himself greatly because of the God of his forefathers. (2 Chronicles 33:12)
- Daniel went **humbling** himself and in behalf of his entire nation before God seeking forgiveness for the errors of their past.
- And he went on to say to me; Do not be afraid, O Daniel, for from the first day that you gave your heart to understanding and **humbling** yourself before your God your words have been heard, and I myself have come because of your words. (Daniel 10:12)
- Paul went to **humbling** himself before others so that he could furnish the Good News without cost to the recipients.
- Or did I commit a sin by **humbling** myself that you might be exalted, because without cost I gladly declared the Good News of God to you? (2 Corinthians 11:7)
