

~HUMILIATED (404)

[English, shamed, mortified, disgraced, shown up, embarrassed, dishonored]

- Yehowah God told Moses that if her own father had spit in Miriam's face, then this would **humiliate** her for seven days.
- Then Yehowah said to Moses; Were her father to spit directly in her face, would she not be **humiliated** seven days? Let her be quarantined seven days outside the camp, and afterward let her be received in. (**Numbers 12:14**)
- Even a captured slave girl whom an Israelite took in marriage, must not be sold as a slave, once he had **humiliated** her by taking her as his wife.
- And it must occur that if you have found no delight in her, you must then send her away, agreeably to her own soul, but you must by no means sell her for money. You must not deal tyrannically with her after you have **humiliated** her. (**Deuteronomy 21:14**)
- A man who **humiliated** another man by lying down with his wife was to be stoned together with the woman.
- You must also bring them both out to the gate of that city and pelt them with stones, and they must die, the girl for the reason that she did not scream in the city, and the man for the reason that he **humiliated** the wife of his fellowman. So you must clear away what is evil from your midst. (**Deuteronomy 22:24**)
- If an Israelite man took a virgin girl and lay down with her, then she must become his wife due to the fact that he **humiliated** her, and he will never be allowed to divorce her.
- The man who lay down with her must also give the girl's father fifty silver shekels, and she will become his wife due to the fact that he **humiliated** her. He will not be allowed to divorce her all his days. (**Deuteronomy 22:29**)
- Naomi asked why they should call her Naomi, **my pleasantness**, when it is Yehowah God who had **humiliated** her.

- I was full when I went, and it is empty-handed that Yehowah has made me return. Why should you call me Naomi, when it is Yehowah that has **humiliated** me and the Almighty that has caused me calamity? (**Ruth 1:21**)
- Saul **humiliated** Jonathan over David his friend, and he did not eat for a day.
- Immediately Jonathan rose up from the table in the heat of anger, and he did not eat bread on the second day after the new moon, for he had been hurt respecting David, because his own father had **humiliated** him. (**1 Samuel 20:34**)
- David told his men to dwell in Jericho when they had been **humiliated** by having their beards shaved off.
- Later people reported it to David, and he at once sent to meet them, because the men had come to feeling very **humiliated**, and the king went on to say; Dwell in Jericho until your beards grow abundantly. Then you must return. (**2 Samuel 10:5**)
- Later people went and told David about the men, and he at once sent to meet them, because they had become men very much **humiliated**, and the king went on to say; Dwell in Jericho until your beards grow abundantly. Then you must return. (**1 Chronicles 19:5**)
- Amnon used strength to take Tamar his sister and have sexual relations with her, thus **humiliating** her. Later Absalom came to hate Amnon over this affair.
- And he did not consent to listen to her voice, but used strength superior to hers and **humiliated** her and lay down with her. (**2 Samuel 13:14**)
- And Absalom did not speak with Amnon either bad or good, for Absalom hated Amnon over the fact that he had **humiliated** Tamar his sister. (**2 Samuel 13:22**)
- However, Jehonadab the son of Shimeah, David's brother, answered and said; Do not let my lord think that it is all the young men the sons of the king that they have put to death, for it is Amnon alone that has died, because at the order of Absalom it

has occurred as something appointed from the day that he **humiliated** Tamar his sister. (2 Samuel 13:32)

- They celebrated the Passover a month late, because the priests and Levites had been **humiliated**, and were not clean.
- After that they slaughtered the Passover victim on the fourteenth day of the second month, and the priests and the Levites themselves had been **humiliated**, so that they sanctified themselves and brought burnt offerings to the house of Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 30:15)
- The Psalmist asked his God to make those hunting for his soul shamed and **humiliated**.
- May those be shamed and **humiliated** who are hunting for my soul. May those be turned back and be abashed who are scheming calamity for me. (Psalms 35:4)
- May those be ashamed and abashed all together who are seeking my soul to sweep it away. May those turn back and be **humiliated** who are delighting in my calamity. (Psalms 40:14)
- O may those hoping in you not be ashamed because of me, O Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies. O may those seeking you not be **humiliated** because of me, O God of Israel. (Psalms 69:6)
- May those be ashamed and abashed who are seeking my soul. May those turn back and be **humiliated** who are taking delight in my calamity. (Psalms 70:2)
- The Psalmist asked his God not to let the crushed one return from him **humiliated**.
- O may the crushed one not return **humiliated**. May the afflicted one and the poor one praise your name. (Psalms 74:21)
- We do not back down from those who get heated up against us, for they are the ones who will become **humiliated** and ashamed. All of those who try to oppose us, are also opposers of God, and they are working actively against his purposes. Surely they will come to nothing and perish. Their way is a way of foolishness.
- Look! All those getting heated up against you will become

ashamed and be **humiliated**. The men in a quarrel with you will become as nothing and will perish. (**Isaiah 41:11**)

- When in the near future Yehowah reveals his glorious presence and awesome power, all of the makers of idol forms will be **humiliated**. They are not the makers of gods, but only of a disgusting thing, a lifeless thing that cannot do anything.
- They will certainly be ashamed and even be **humiliated**, all of them. Together in humiliation the manufacturers of idol forms will have to walk. (**Isaiah 45:16**)
- All who look to Israel's God, who is real, true and able to save, will never again be **humiliated**. Israel will not need to be ashamed, for they have not believed in a lie. Their God will guide and protect them, even into the time of eternity.
- As for Israel, he will certainly be saved in union with Yehowah with a salvation for times indefinite. You people will not be ashamed, nor will you be **humiliated** for the indefinite times of eternity. (**Isaiah 45:17**)
- Isaiah speaks for the Son of Man the Messiah, saying that the sovereign Lord will help him, and so he would not come to feel **humiliated**.
- But the Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself will help me. That is why I shall not have to feel **humiliated**. That is why I have set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be ashamed. (**Isaiah 50:7**)
- The true sons of Zion must not then be afraid of false anointed ones who reproach and slander, for these true sons have a husbandly owner, Yehowah God. For them, there will be no **humiliation** ever again, for Yehowah will bring his true purposes to life through them. God's **woman** then rejoices in pure worship, and forgets the **shame** of her youth.
- The time when you were in a captured exiled state under the great harlot. All of those difficult years when you foretold the coming forth of God's sons, but none came forth, and no one would put faith in you. Now you have sons and therefore a husband!
- Do not be afraid, for you will not be put to shame, and do not feel

humiliated, for you will not be disappointed. For you will forget even the shame of your time of youth, and the reproach of your continuous widowhood you will remember no more. (**Isaiah 54:4**)

- Today these copious showers, are a downpour of truth and spiritual understanding that have been withheld from Jehovah's Witnesses for many years. Thus, they have no deeply spiritual books to study today. Even the spring rains, that are given every year to support her three annual conventions are lacking. For the last twenty years, each of their conventions is nearly a carbon copy of the last, with no new understanding forthcoming. Still they have refused to feel **humiliated**.
- So copious showers are withheld, and not even a spring rain has occurred. And the forehead of a wife committing prostitution is what has become yours. You have refused to feel **humiliated**. (**Jeremiah 3:3**)
- In the fall of **1985 C.E**, Jehovah's Witnesses rejected fine instruction from Yehowah in the book, **Revealing The Sons Of God**, when they refused to even read it. Yet to date they have felt no shame. They feel that they do no wrong, and so **humiliation** will stay far from them. Yet this very thing, the rejection of the Messiah, will cause them a **humiliating** downfall.
- Did they feel shame because it was something detestable that they had done? For one thing, they positively do not feel any shame, for another thing, they have not come to know even how to feel **humiliated**. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling, in the time that I must hold an accounting with them they will stumble, Yehowah has said. (**Jeremiah 6:15**)
- They refuse to be ashamed or feel **humiliated**, by what they have done to their spirit anointed brothers or to the Christ, but instead they push all of their causes for shame aside, and call everyone else apostates. They are sure to stumble over the wicked deeds, that they have perpetrated against God's true servants.
- Did they feel shame because they had done even what was detestable? For one thing, they positively could not feel ashamed, for another thing, they did not know even how to feel **humiliated**. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling. In the time of their being given attention, they will stumble,

Yehowah has said. ([Jeremiah 8:12](#))

- Yehowah, the great shepherd, will shepherd all of the false shepherds who have abused his sheep among his people, with a wind of judgment. It will be a destructive wind and one that will cause Christendom and Judaism's downfall. Their calamity will cause them to feel **humiliated** for currently they act as if they can do no wrong and so they rebuff all counsel.
- A wind will shepherd all your own shepherds, and as for those intensely loving you, they will go into captivity itself. For at that time you will be ashamed and certainly feel **humiliated** because of all your calamity. ([Jeremiah 22:22](#))
- The **reproach of their youth**, within Christendom's members, **is the worship of idols and continuing in falsehoods**. They will have to be **led to know** Yehowah in truth, for they have refused to take counsel from his appointed servants.
- Once Jacob comes down, then Spiritual Israel will be in power over all the earth, and all mankind will be led to know the ways of Yehowah. They will then, become **ashamed** and **humiliated**, over the reproach of their youth, as they see what things true worship involves.
- For after my turning back I felt regret, and after my being led to know I made a slap upon the thigh. I became ashamed, and I also felt **humiliated**, for I had carried the reproach of my youth. ([Jeremiah 31:19](#))
- Yehowah will diminish Jehovah's Witnesses by exposing their wrongdoing to other religious groups. This will cause many not to want to be any part of Jehovah's Witnesses, thus diminishing them. The other religions that have had their own religious prostitutions exposed by Jehovah's Witnesses will fulfill their soulful desire to see Jehovah's Witnesses name dragged through the mud. They will see Jehovah's Witnesses **humiliated**, just as they have been over child-abusing priests.
- And, look! I shall certainly stretch out my hand against you and I shall diminish your allowance and give you to the soulful desire of the women hating you, the daughters of the Philistines, the women **humiliated** on account of your way as regards loose conduct. ([Ezekiel 16:27](#))

- The proper way to listen to counsel is to always say; Could this apply to me? Am I in the wrong here? Then we must truly examine our hearts and our past actions. Our God Yehowah will **humble** and then **humiliate** if necessary anyone who pridefully acts against his counsels. When an organization accepts such thinking and then persists in it, then it to must be **humbled** and it's people brought to repentance. Jehovah's Witnesses have brought comfort to Christendom by being even worse than they are.
- In order, that you may bear your humiliation, and you must feel **humiliated** owing to all that you have done, in that you comforted them. ([Ezekiel 16:54](#))
- Jehovah's Witnesses will forever remember that their organization did these things to anointed ones and they rejected the Messiah. They despised divine truth calling it apostasy and all because they worshipped mere men and their ideas.
- After their **humiliation** Jehovah's Witnesses will accept the new understanding and then other Christian nations will become like daughters to them because they are far more advanced at understanding the language of the truth.
- And you will certainly remember your ways and feel **humiliated** when you receive your sisters, the ones older than you as well as the ones younger than you, and I shall certainly give them to you as daughters, but not owing to your covenant. ([Ezekiel 16:61](#))
- Exposing a person's nakedness is a public **humiliation**. With a father it shows a lack of respect for older ones. A woman in her menstruation being **humiliated** would indicate her being forced to have relations during this time and thus showing disrespect for her life.
- The nakedness of a father they have uncovered in you, a woman unclean in her menstruation they have **humiliated** in you. ([Ezekiel 22:10](#))
- Adultery, fornication and incest exist inside of the doomed city. Time will bring it to light causing their **humiliation**.
- And with the wife of his companion a man has done a detestable thing, and his own daughter-in-law a man has defiled with loose conduct, and his sister, the daughter of his own father, a man has **humiliated** in you. ([Ezekiel 22:11](#))

- Why had Israel lost God's favor and been **humiliated** for 70 years in exile? It happened because their kings had led them astray and their priesthood rejected God's word of truth. They must measure the pattern. Discipline is applied when we do not measure up. It is a corrective step meant to bring one in line with the pattern. Therefore they must learn from the pattern of their previous transgressions, feel **humiliated** over their detestable acts, come to a state of repentance before Yehowah and then he would come back to them.
- As for you, O son of man, inform the house of Israel about the House, that they may feel **humiliated** because of their errors, and they must measure the pattern. (**Ezekiel 43:10**)
- The temple of Yehowah is the place where he resides among the sons of men. It must meet his complete specifications and its living stones must know the pattern of all of its specifications and Laws so as to handle the holy things properly and to maintain cleanness.
- And if they actually feel **humiliated** because of all that they have done, the ground plan of the House, and its arrangement and its exits and its entryways, and all its ground plans and all its specifications, and all its ground plans and all its laws do you make known to them and write before their eyes, in order, that they may observe all its ground plan and all its specifications and may actually carry them out. (**Ezekiel 43:11**)
- Jesus then showed, that the later man, the tax collector, upon going down to his home, proved more righteous than the self-righteous Pharisee. For everyone who exalts himself, will be **humbled**, but he that **humbles** himself, will be exalted.
- I tell you, This man went down to his home proved more righteous than that man, because everyone that exalts himself will be **humiliated**, but he that humbles himself will be exalted. (**Luke 18:14**)
- Christ will then refashion their **humiliated** bodies to conform to his glorious body, for all authority and power have been given to him, as he is now enthroned in the heaven. He has the authority to make all things subject to himself.
- Who will refashion our **humiliated** body to be conformed to his glorious body according to the operation of the power that he

has, even to subject all things to himself. (**Philippians 3:21**)
