

~HUMILIATING (37)

[English, embarrassing, mortifying, shameful, degrading, crushing]

- The Psalmist speaks of Yehowah as casting off Israel and **humiliating** them for they refused his discipline and teachings.
- But now you have cast off and keep **humiliating** us, and you do not go forth with our armies. (**Psalms 44:9**)
- Isaiah prophesies about the Messiah whose face was not concealed from **humiliating** things and spit.
- My back I gave to the strikers, and my cheeks to those plucking off the hair. My face I did not conceal from **humiliating** things and spit. (**Isaiah 50:6**)
- Yehowah speaks of his returning exiles as ones who will no longer have to suffer from **humiliating** talk from the nations.
- And I shall cause no further **humiliating** talk by the nations to be heard concerning you, and reproach by peoples you will bear no more, and your nations you will no more cause to stumble, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 36:15**)
- Daniel spoke of how Nebuchadnezzar was given by God power to **humiliate** peoples.
- And because of the greatness that He gave him, all peoples, national groups and languages proved to be quaking and showing fear before him. Whom he happened to want to, he was killing, and whom he happened to want to, he was striking, and whom he happened to want to, he was exalting, and whom he happened to want to, he was **humiliating**. (**Daniel 5:19**)
