

~HUPPIM (96)
(Hup'pim)

- A son, or descendant, of Benjamin included in the list of those who came into Egypt with Jacob's household in **1728 B.C.E.** or were born there during Jacob's lifetime.
- Now these are the names of Israel's sons who came into Egypt; Jacob and his sons, Jacob's firstborn was Reuben. (**Genesis 46:8**)
- And the sons of Benjamin were Bela and Becher and Ashbel, Gera and Naaman, Ehi and Rosh, Muppim and **Huppim** and Ard. (**Genesis 46:21**)
- Other passages suggest that he was either a grandson or great-grandson through Bela and Iri.
- The sons of Benjamin were Bela and Becher and Jediael, three. (**1 Chronicles 7:6**)
- And the sons of Bela were Ezbon and Uzzi and Uzziel and Jerimoth and Iri, five, heads of the house of their forefathers, valiant, mighty men, and their genealogical enrollment was twenty-two thousand and thirty-four. (**1 Chronicles 7:7**)
- And the Shuppim and the **Huppim** were the sons of Israel, the Hushim were the sons of Aher. (**1 Chronicles 7:12**)
- As for Benjamin, he became father to Bela his firstborn, Ashbel the second and Aharah the third. (**1 Chronicles 8:1**)
- Nohah the fourth and Rapha the fifth. (**1 Chronicles 8:2**)
- And Bela came to have sons, Addar and Gera and Abihud. (**1 Chronicles 8:3**)
- And Abishua and Naaman and Ahoah. (**1 Chronicles 8:4**)
- And Gera and Shephuphan and Hiram. (**1 Chronicles 8:5**)
- He is apparently called Hiram. Time barely allows for Benjamin to have had grandsons when entering Egypt, but,

- Now these are the names of Israel's sons who came into Egypt: Jacob and his sons, Jacob's firstborn was Reuben. (**Genesis 46:8**)
- Might be understood to indicate that all these souls had been born while Jacob was still alive even down in Egypt, not necessarily born before he and his household went there. The family that **Huppim**, also called **Hupham**, founded, called **Huphamites**, is numbered among the tribe of Benjamin in the second wilderness census of the Israelites.
- And it came about after the scourge, that Yehowah went on to say this to Moses and Eleazar the son of Aaron the priest. (**Numbers 26:1**)
- Take the sum of the whole assembly of the sons of Israel from twenty years of age and upward, according to the house of their fathers, all those going out to the army in Israel. (**Numbers 26:2**)
- And Moses and Eleazar the priest proceeded to speak with them in the desert plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho, saying; (**Numbers 26:3**)
- Take the sum of them from the age of twenty years and upward, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. Now the sons of Israel who went out of the land of Egypt were. (**Numbers 26:4**)
- The sons of Benjamin by their families were, of Bela the family of the Belaites. Of Ashbel the family of the Ashbelites. Of Ahiram the family of the Ahiramites. (**Numbers 26:38**)
- Of Shephupham the family of the Shuphamites. Of Hupham the family of the Huphamites. (**Numbers 26:39**)
- **Huppim** is mentioned also at;
- The sons of Manasseh were Asriel, whom his Syrian concubine bore. She bore Machir the father of Gilead. (**1 Chronicles 7:14**)
- And Machir himself took a wife for **Huppim** and for Shuppim, and the name of his sister was Maacah. And the name of the second was Zelophehad, but Zelophehad came to have daughters. (**1 Chronicles 7:15**)
- In association with Manasseh, but the connection is unclear.
