

### ~HURTFULNESS (83)

[English, Actions that are, upsetting, unkind, cruel, spiteful, cutting, wounding, insensitive, tactless, inappropriate, Opposite of, **kindness**]

- Job showed that God himself would store up a man's **hurtfulness** for one's own sons.
- God himself will store up ones **hurtfulness** for one's own sons, he will reward him that he may know it. (**Job 21:19**)
- The wicked ones words are **hurtfulness** and deception, lacking in good insight.
- The words of his mouth are **hurtfulness** and deception, he has ceased to have insight for doing good. (**Psalms 36:3**)
- **Hurtfulness** is what the wicked one keeps scheming upon his bed.
- **Hurtfulness** is what he keeps scheming upon his bed. He stations himself on a way that is not good. What is bad he does not reject. (**Psalms 36:4**)
- The Psalmist showed that there, the practicers of **hurtfulness** have fallen, pushed down and unable to get up again.
- There the practicers of **hurtfulness** have fallen, they have been pushed down and have been unable to get up. (**Psalms 36:12**)
- The wicked ones go around the wall of the city and **hurtfulness** and trouble are within it.
- Day and night they go round about it upon its walls, and **hurtfulness** and trouble are within it. (**Psalms 55:10**)
- The Psalmist asked for Yehowah God to bring down the people because of their **hurtfulness**.
- On account of their **hurtfulness** cast them forth. In anger bring down even the peoples, O God. (**Psalms 56:7**)

- The Psalmist asked who would take his stand against the practicers of **hurtfulness** for him.
- Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? Who will take his stand for me against the practicers of **hurtfulness**? (**Psalms 94:16**)
- The Psalmist showed that Yehowah God would himself silence the practicers of **hurtfulness**, and bring upon them calamity.
- And he will turn back upon them their **hurtfulness** and will silence them with their own calamity. Yehowah our God will silence them. (**Psalms 94:23**)
- A good-for-nothing man, a man of **hurtfulness**, is walking with a crooked tongue.
- A good-for-nothing man, a man of **hurtfulness**, is walking with crookedness of speech. (**Proverbs 6:12**)
- The evildoer is paying attention to the lip of **hurtfulness**.
- The evildoer is paying attention to the lip of **hurtfulness**. A falsifier is giving ear to the tongue causing adversities. (**Proverbs 17:4**)
- It is the religious leaders of Christendom and of Jehovah's Witnesses that are scheming **hurtfulness** and advising bad counsel against their own interests.
