## ~HYACINTH (14) (hy'a-cinth) [Greek, hy-a'kin-thos]

- A deep-blue semiprecious stone, in Greek, hy-a'kin-thos. Primarily the word referred to the flower by that name, probably describing the dark-blue iris. The 11th of the foundation stones of New Jerusalem is said to be hyacinth.
- The fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh hyacinth, the twelfth amethyst. (Revelation 21:20)
