

~HYACINTH (14)

(hy'a-cinth) [Greek, *hy-a'kin-thos*]

- **A deep-blue semiprecious stone**, in Greek, *hy-a'kin-thos*. Primarily the word referred to the flower by that name, probably describing the dark-blue iris. The 11th of the foundation stones of New Jerusalem is said to be **hyacinth**.
- The fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh **hyacinth**, the twelfth amethyst. (**Revelation 21:20**)
