(Id'do)[1-5, shortened form of Adaiah, meaning Yehowah Has Decked [the nameholder]

- A prophet, father of Berechiah and grandfather of the prophet Zechariah.
- And Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the grandson of Iddo the prophet prophesied to the Jews who were in Judah and in Jerusalem, in the name of the God of Israel who was over them. (Ezra 5:1)
- And the older men of the Jews were building and making progress under the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the grandson of Iddo, and they built and finished it due to the order of the God of Israel and due to the order of Cyrus and Darius and Artaxerxes the king of Persia.
