

~IGNORANCE (43)

[English, lack of knowledge, unawareness, Opposite of, knowledge]

- Peter realized that the Jewish people acted in **ignorance** when they rejected Christ.
- And now, brothers, I know that you acted in **ignorance**, just as your rulers also did. (**Acts of Apostles 3:17**)
- Paul spoke of religious **ignorance** and how God had overlooked such ignorance among pagan peoples in the past but that he was now telling people everywhere to repent.
- True, God has overlooked the times of such **ignorance**, yet now he is telling mankind that they should all everywhere repent. (**Acts of Apostles 17:30**)
- Paul spoke of those in darkness mentally, because of their **ignorance** of God's ways and the insensibility of their hearts.
- While they are in darkness mentally, and alienated from the life that belongs to God, because of the **ignorance** that is in them, because of the insensibility of their hearts. (**Ephesians 4:18**)
- The High Priest entered the Most Holy yearly for the sins of **ignorance** of the people and for himself.
- But into the second compartment the High Priest alone enters once a year, not without blood, which he offers for himself and for the sins of **ignorance** of the people. (**Hebrews 9:7**)
- Peter counsels Christians to quit being fashioned according to the desires that formerly possessed while they were **ignorant** of God's ways and spirit.
- As obedient children, quit being fashioned according to the desires you formerly had in your ignorance. (**1 Peter 1:14**)
