[English, unnoticed, unobserved, overlooked, unseen, disregarded, without being seen]

- Dehovah's Witnesses could have nurtured, guided and if necessary corrected these sons, but instead they took a bloodguilty course, one they laid out for themselves. Their wicked acts, follow them like tracks in the ground. They lead right to the ones who are bloodguilty before Yehowah.
- They chose to ignore the way of peace, so that they, like Joseph's brothers, could maintain their dominance over God's flock. Neither them, nor anyone who persists in following in their way, will ever know peace from God.
- The way of peace they have ignored, and there is no justice in their tracks. Their roadways they have made crooked for themselves. No one at all treading in them will actually know peace. (Isaiah 59:8)
- Jeremiah showed that Israel's leaders were low class of men spiritually and morally, for they had ignored the way of Yehowah God, sidestepped the judgment of this God.
- Even I myself had said; Surely they are of low class. They acted foolishly, for they have ignored the way of Yehowah, the judgment of their God. (Jeremiah 5:4)
- These religious leaders bend their tongue as a weapon used in falsehood, going from badness to badness and ignoring Yehowah God's fine way.
- And they bend their tongue as their bow in falsehood, but not for faithfulness have they proved mighty in the land. For from badness to badness they went forth, and they ignored even me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 9:3)
- After the destruction of all false religion by the United Nations, then Yehowah will quickly turn against the irreligious nations, who have ignored his wise counsel, and who have continued pursuing a course of trying to exterminate his people Jacob, the Spiritual Israel of God.
