

~IMAGINED (28)

[English, likely, probable, anticipated, predictable, expected, unlikely]

- The men of Benjamin were lured out of their city by **imagining** that Israel was facing defeat.
- However, the sons of Benjamin **imagined** that the men of Israel faced defeat when they kept giving ground to Benjamin because they trusted in the ambush that they had set against Gibeah. (**Judges 20:36**)
- Through the Psalmist Yehowah speaks to men who **imagined** that their God would somehow become like them.
- These things you have done, and I kept silent. You **imagined** that I would positively become like you. I am going to reprove you, and I will set things in order before your eyes. (**Psalms 50:21**)
- Jesus disciples **imagined** that his talk about his upcoming death was in fact talk about his sleeping.
- Jesus had spoken, however, about his death. But they **imagined** he was speaking about taking rest in sleep. (**John 11:13**)
