~IMLAH (29) (Im'lah) [May God Fill, or, May God Cause to Reign]

- Father of Micaiah, a prophet of Yehowah contemporaneous with Kings Ahab and Jehoshaphat.
- To that the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat; There is still one man through whom to inquire of Yehowah, but I myself certainly hate him, for he does not prophesy good things concerning me but bad, Micaiah the son of Imlah. However, Jehoshaphat said; Do not let the king say a thing like that. (1 Kings 22:8)
- Accordingly the king of Israel called a certain court official and said; Do bring Micaiah the son of Imlah quickly. (1 Kings 22:9)
- At that the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat; There is still one man through whom to inquire of Yehowah, but I myself certainly hate him, for he is prophesying concerning me, not for good, but, all his days, for bad. He is Micaiah the son of Imlah. However, Jehoshaphat said; Do not let the king say a thing like that. (2 Chronicles 18:7)
- Accordingly the king of Israel called a court official and said; Bring Micaiah the son of Imlah quickly. (2 Chronicles 18:8)
