

## ~IMPLORE (57)

[English, beg, beseech, plead, entreat, pray]

- Moses **implored** Yehowah God to let him pass over and to see the good land he had promised to his people Israel.
- And I proceeded to **implore** favor from Yehowah at that particular time, saying; (**Deuteronomy 3:23**)
- The third chief of fifty sent to Elijah to bring him before the king, first **implored** Elijah to spare him and his men.
- And he went sending again a third chief of fifty and his fifty. But the third chief of fifty went up and came and bent down upon his knees in front of Elijah and began to **implore** favor of him and speak to him; Man of the true God, please let my soul and the soul of these fifty servants of yours be precious in your eyes. (**2 Kings 1:13**)
- Mordecai asked Esther to go before the king and implore him in behalf of her people.
- And a copy of the writing of the Law that had been given in Shushan to have them annihilated he gave him to show Esther and to tell her and to lay the command upon her to come in to the king and **implore** favor of him and make request directly before him for her own people. (**Esther 4:8**)
- Bildad reasoned to Job that if he would **implore** Yehowah God, he would understand his situation better.
- If you yourself will look for God, and if of the Almighty you will **implore** favor. (**Job 8:5**)
- Job showed that even toward an opponent at a legal case he would **implore** his favor.
- Whom I would not answer, even though I were really in the right. Of my opponent-at-law I would **implore** favor. (**Job 9:15**)
- Also Yehowah God refers to the contending with one of his angels that Jacob later did to obtain a blessing, so that he gradually

prevailed. At Bethel he wept before his God to **implore** his favor, and there he got to find Yehowah God, and it was in Bethel that Yehowah God began speaking to Jacob, as he had spoken to Abraham and Isaac before him.

- And he kept contending with an angel and gradually prevailed. He wept, that he might **implore** favor for himself. At Bethel He got to find him, and there He began talking with us. (**Hosea 12:4**)
