

## **~INCITED (57)**

**[English, encouraged, provoked, driven, impelled, pressed, prompted]**

- The Israelites, everyone who heart **incited** him to give, came with the contribution for the tent of meeting.
- Then they came, everyone whose heart impelled him, and they brought, everyone whose spirit **incited** him, Yehowah's contribution for the work of the tent of meeting and for all its service and for the holy garments. (**Exodus 35:21**)
- Every man and woman whose hearts **incited** them to bring something for all the work that Yehowah had commanded to make by means of Moses did so, the sons of Israel brought a voluntary offering to Yehowah. (**Exodus 35:29**)
- Israel **incited** Yehowah God to jealousy with their vain idols.
- They, for their part, have **incited** me to jealousy with what is no god. They have vexed me with their vain idols. I, for my part, shall incite them to jealousy with what is no people. With a stupid nation I shall offend them. (**Deuteronomy 32:21**)
- David would willingly offer a gift offering to Yehowah God if he was behind the actions Saul had **incited** against him.
- And now let my lord the king, please, listen to the words of his servant; If it is Yehowah that has **incited** you against me, let him smell a grain offering. But if it is the sons of man, they are cursed before Yehowah, because they have driven me out today from feeling myself attached to the inheritance of Yehowah, saying; Go, serve other gods! (**1 Samuel 26:19**)
- Satan the Devil **incited** David to take a census of all Israel.
- And again the anger of Yehowah came to be hot against Israel, when one **incited** David against them, saying; Go, take a count of Israel and Judah. (**2 Samuel 24:1**)
- The men of Judah **incited** Yehowah God to jealousy more even than any of their forefathers before them.

- And Judah went on doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah, so that they **incited** him to jealousy more than all that their forefathers had done by their sins with which they sinned. (**1 Kings 14:22**)
- The prophets of Samaria had acted as prophets **incited** by Baal, causing the people of Israel to wander from Yehowah God's true worship.
- And in the prophets of Samaria I have seen impropriety. They have acted as prophets **incited** by Baal, and they keep making my people, even Israel, wander about. (**Jeremiah 23:13**)
